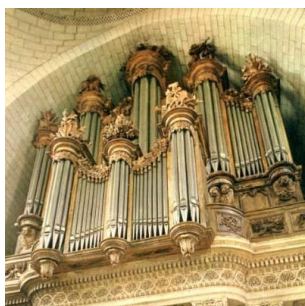

CHORAL
